Everyone is invited to be part of creating something beautiful in our community.

Whether you submit a design or not, come paint with us this summer.

Can't participate in this project? We already have requests for more murals in the future!

HOW TO SUBMIT:

Deadline: 11:59 p.m. June 15, 2022

Submissions must follow the native Indiana Flora and Fauna theme.

Artwork must be an original work of art.

Any medium, except photography, is acceptable.

Email your submission to: parksart@newchicagoin.gov

Include your name and a way to contact you on your submission.

A committee of Northwest Indiana artists aged 8 and up will choose the artworks to be included in the mural.

Everyone who submits a design and helps paint will be invited to attend the mural exhibition event where their contributions will be acknowledged.

Artists whose designs are used will be acknowledged on a plaque at Twin Oaks Park.

A release document will be required for designs used in the mural granting the town of New Chicago use of the artwork in the mural.

Please understand that your work may be adapted or modified for use in the mural.
